That may seem like strong language, but this is a very serious problem.

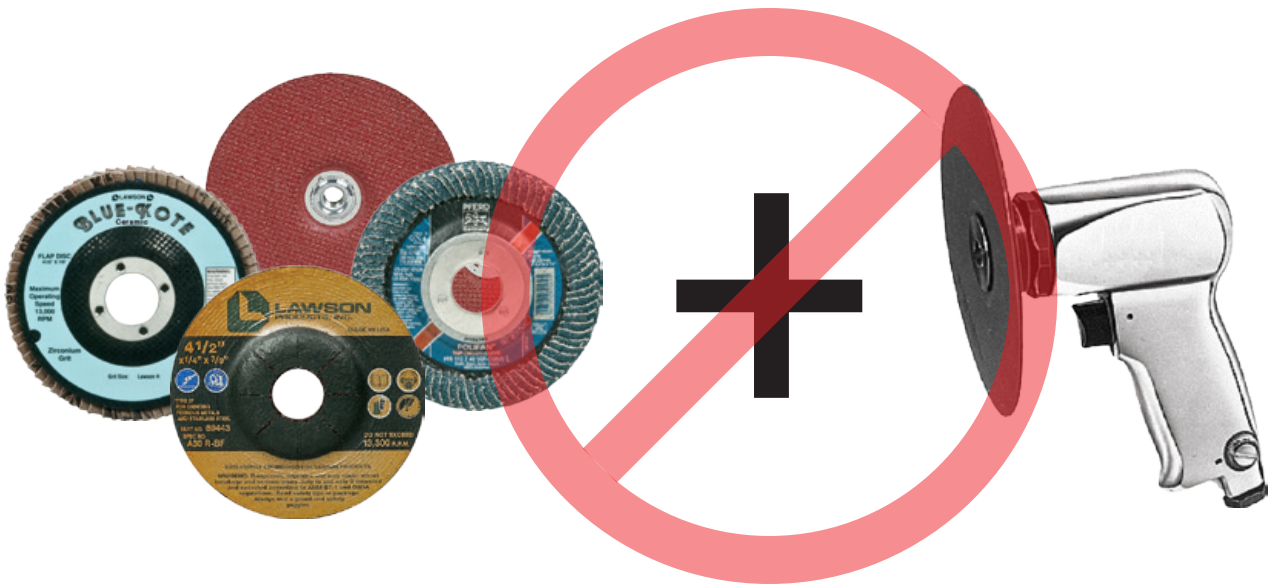
There have been numerous serious injuries resulting from the use of high-speed, pistol-grip air sanders mounted with grinding wheels. Because the speed of these air sanders far exceeds the maximum rated speeds for grinding wheels, a potentially lethal wheel breakage may occur.

A few words of caution:

- **Never** use a high-speed air sander as a portable grinder
- **Only** use sanding discs specifically designed for air sanders
- **Always** wear proper safety equipment

Always be aware of and follow the cautionary guidelines printed on the grinding wheel blotter. In short, **never** use air sanders and grinding wheels together.

Whenever you use any piece of grinding or sanding equipment, use it as though your life depends on it.



Pistol-grip sanders should **ONLY be used with coated abrasives.**

Type 1 and Type 27 grinding wheels and flap discs should **NEVER be mounted on pistol-grip sanders.**
